

Test Prep Scholarship Application

Graph It Forward Today (GIFT) provides SAT/ACT test prep scholarships to qualified high school students who are committed to pursuing higher education. GIFT seeks to help prepare college bound students for these standardized tests – vital in the college admissions process – by providing an award-winning, nationally recognized test prep program, the WilsonDailyPrep. Students will receive one-to-one online tutoring along with daily online quizzes. All GIFT students are eligible to receive a graphing calculator*, a vital educational tool that is required in many high school and college math classes as well as on most standardized tests.

GIFT encourages applications from motivated, hard working students who are committed to practicing 3 hours per week.

Students/Schools/Organizations are required to:

- Provide test scores before beginning our test prep program or when received if test prep started before scores have been released.
- Take the SAT and/or ACT within 6 months of beginning the program
- Complete at least 17 WilsonDailypreps (via the online questions of the day that are provided with the scholarship) each month for a *minimum* of three months*
- Complete all homework assignments
- Report test scores upon completion of our program

*Students who actively participate in the test prep program for a minimum of three months and do not own a graphing calculator will be awarded a graphing calculator.
